San Francisco Cinematheque, a nonprofit arts organization, has filed an application with the City of San Francisco to close Rodgers Street from Folsom to its end in order to present an outdoor film and video exhibition called “**The Illuminated Corridor.**”

The exhibition will include projection of film and video on the building façade opposite businesses and residences on Rodgers Street.

Additional projection will take place in the parking lot of 301 8th Street adjacent to the end of Rodgers Street.

This exhibition is in partnership with **The Prelinger Library** housed at 301 8th Street and part of a series of art events (“**Live Cinema**”) taking place throughout San Francisco in October and November.

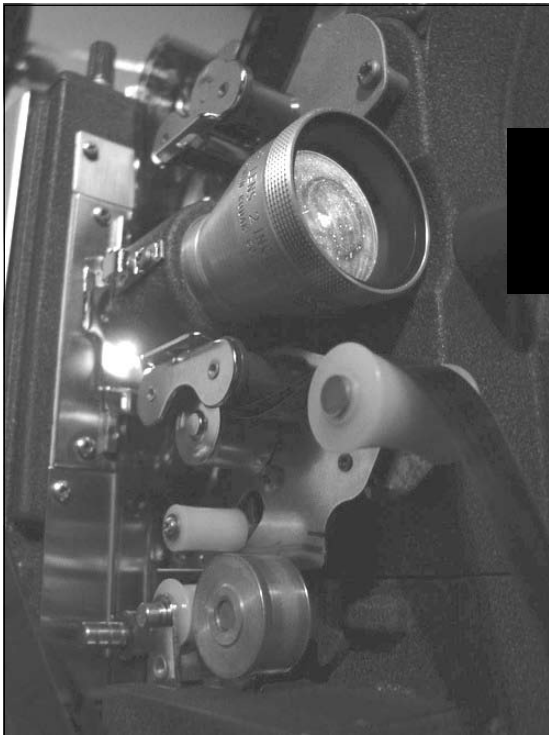
